Job Description – Communication Officer

Purpose of the Role

The **Communications Officer** is responsible for managing internal and external communication for Child-Help International Tanzania. This position ensures that the organisation's mission, impact, and values are communicated authentically from the local context to national and international audiences.

This role represents a key step in localising communication, enabling stories, results, and voices to be shared directly from the Global South.

Key Responsibilities

- Develop and implement a communication strategy aligned with Child-Help's mission and vision under the guidance of the Fundraising and Communication Manager.
- Create and manage content for social media, website, newsletters, and reports inline with the developed communication strategy.
- Collect and write impact stories from communities, children, and families.
- Support fundraising campaigns through strong storytelling and visual content.
- Ensure ethical and respectful communication about children and disability.
- Maintain consistent branding and messaging across all platforms.
- Liaise with international partners and the global Child-Help country members and programs.
